June Maintenance Update

As we enter the summer season, the course is in strong condition. Major maintenance initiatives have been completed to promote long-term turf health, elevate playability standards, and maintain a clean, well-presented appearance throughout the grounds

Fairway Findings

If your group or league plays **“out of bounds = two-stroke penalty,”** then you add two strokes to your score for that hole. Placing the ball back in play to speed things up doesn’t add anything extra — the only penalty is the two strokes for going OB.

1. So, the sequence is:
 2. Ball goes out of bounds → +2 strokes
 3. You place the ball where your group agrees → no additional penalty
 4. Play your next shot from that spot

Pickleball Corner

A proper pickleball warm-up takes 8–10 minutes and uses dynamic, full-body movements to boost performance and prevent injuries. Warming up reduces the risk of strains, sprains, tennis elbow, rotator cuff issues, Achilles tendonitis, and plantar fasciitis. It also sharpens coordination, reaction time, and overall movement so you feel quicker and more prepared on the court.
