Course News & Grounds Report

Comments from the “Top of the Hill” Our Alta Sierra Country Club Grounds Superintendent Jeff Hill

Course Infrastructure & Safety Update

The maintenance team has been hard at work implementing two major upgrades to elevate the playing experience across the course.

Fairway & Turf Aerification

To promote healthier, more resilient turf, the team recently completed aerification of the fairways, roughs, and green surrounds. This essential process involved removing small soil cores to relieve compaction caused by foot and cart traffic. The benefits include:

- Improved water infiltration and air exchange in the root zone
- Deeper, stronger root growth
- Enhanced resistance to drought and disease
- Firmer, more consistent playing surfaces throughout the course

These efforts ensure that Alta Sierra remains in top condition for golfers year-round.

Tee Box Renovation on Hole 1

The white tee box on Hole Number 1 received a full makeover to improve both aesthetics and playability:

- **Leveled surface** for a perfectly flat and consistent hitting area
- **Expanded tee size** to allow for better rotation of tee markers, reducing wear
- **Fresh Bermuda grass sod** laid to promote faster healing of divots

This upgrade sets a strong tone for every round, offering golfers a pristine start from the very first tee.



Fairway Findings

It's easy to overlook the everyday comforts we enjoy at the clubhouse and across the golf course—especially the well-maintained restrooms on the front and back nine. Behind their cleanliness and freshness is the dedicated work of our housekeeping team.

Next time you see **Nancy** cruising by in her golf cart, greeting members with a warm smile and friendly wave, take a moment to return the gesture. A cheerful "hello" and a heartfelt thank-you go a long way in showing appreciation for the care she brings to Alta Sierra every day.
