Course News & Grounds Report

Comments from the “Top of the Hill” Our Alta Sierra Country Club Grounds Superintendent Jeff Hill

Course Infrastructure & Safety Update

The course has made significant strides in overall conditioning this season. From improved turf health to upgraded irrigation and ongoing vegetation control, the efforts of our maintenance team are clearly paying off. We're committed to delivering a high-quality playing experience while continuing to address long-term maintenance goals.

Turf, Fairway & Green Care: Dead turf on holes 12, 16, and the practice green has been replaced with Pure Distinction Bent grass. Greens and tees were aerified and top-dressed with USGA sand. Fertilizer, fungicide, and weed control are ongoing, with increased hand-watering. Fairway aerification wraps up the turf care program this month.

Trees & Vegetation: Oleanders near hole 14 were trimmed, creeks on holes 1 and 18 cleared, and blackberry overgrowth is being treated.

Irrigation Improvements: System adjustments have improved efficiency. Thirty new sprinkler heads are replacing outdated units.

Wildlife & Pest Control: Gopher control continues daily. Beaver activity near hole 15 persists; we're awaiting federal trapper support.

Bunkers and Course Features: Edges are being sprayed to prevent weeds and ensure consistent play conditions.

Fairway Findings

The condition of our greens and overall landscape has seen a remarkable improvement over the past three months. We encourage everyone to extend their thanks to our dedicated maintenance team, who begin their work as early as 5:30 AM to ensure the course remains both beautiful and professionally maintained.
